Fido Friday Policy

Please read the following important information before bringing your dog to the America's Family Pet Expo.

AFPE will be very crowded and your dog will be in close proximity with many other animals of all types. If your dog does not react well in crowds and with other animals, please do not bring them to the Expo.

- AFPE reserves the right to refuse entry to any person or animal for any cause deemed not in the best interest of the Expo, and/or to have any person or animal removed from the show site for any cause deemed not in the best interest of the Expo.
- All dogs must be healthy, free from parasites and have all necessary core and noncore shots including rabies, distemper and bordatella etc.
- Dogs that have been cited by California statute or other applicable state statutes as dangerous and/or vicious are prohibited from entry into the Expo.
- You must be able to control your dog in a crowd and make sure that the dog is not aggressive or potentially harmful to someone or another animal
- Only one dog per adult (18 yrs and older) is permitted. The adult must always be in control of the dog.
- Pet owners, bringing their dog into the Expo, accept the potential exposures to the health and safety of their dog.
- Should your dog act in any way considered by Expo Staff to be aggressive or dangerous you will be asked to leave the Expo and will not be entitled to any refund
- Fido Friday pertains only to dogs. Attendees may not bring any other type of pet into the Expo
- Dogs must be kept on a leash (not retractable and no longer than 6') or enclosed in a pet-friendly enclosure. If animal is removed, or enclosure is opened, animal must be on a leash
- Dogs must be a minimum of 4 months old
- Dogs must be licensed and wearing current tags
- Dogs must be spayed/neutered
- Dogs are to use designated potty areas and owners/handlers are required to clean up after their dogs
- Pet owners/handlers must abide by the rules set forth and must sign a liability waiver upon admission to America's Family Pet Expo
- Should any issues arise or you have any question/concerns while attending the Expo, please go to the AFPE Show Office in building 18.
